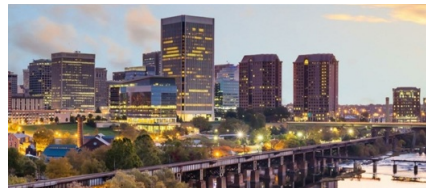

Grain Market Report

Mainly because of smaller than previously estimated crops of wheat and barley in Canada, Russia and the USA, the forecast for world total grains (wheat and coarse grains) production in 2021/22 is cut by 12m t m/m (month-on-month), to 2,283m, up by 3% y/y (year-on-year). The projection for consumption is reduced by 7m t m/m, mostly linked to lower figures for feeding of wheat and barley amid a tighter supply Outlook.

World Agricultural Supply and Demand Estimates

The global wheat outlook for 2021/22 is for reduced supplies, lower consumption, reduced trade, and smaller ending stocks. Supplies are projected to decline 16.8 million tons to 1,065.7 million, primarily on lower production for Russia, Canada, and the United States. Russia's production is reduced 12.5 million tons to 72.5 million on decreased winter wheat production, which is only slightly offset by higher spring wheat

Climate change widespread, rapid, and intensifying - IPCC

The report provides new estimates of the chances of crossing the global warming level of 1.5°C in the next decades, and finds that unless there are immediate, rapid and large-scale reductions in greenhouse gas emissions, limiting warming to close to 1.5°C or even 2°C will be beyond reach.. -->> -->>
